Easing of Restrictions

As I write, there is no new guidance for schools and the expectation is that all current restrictions and systems remain in place until further advice is given.

Therefore, please continue to help us to keep everyone safe by observing our bubble, facemasks and distancing rules, especially at drop off and pick up.

I will let you know of any changes as soon as I am informed.

Even when restrictions are lifted, we intend to keep to the staggered entry and exit times as they are for the remainder of the year as this has had massive benefits in managing the difficult carparking and traffic situation at the school.

From September, we will be looking to move to a staggered system whereby KS1 and KS2 have staggered entry and exit times. Details later in the year.
