In-school workshops

- Consultation with SENCo/Parent Support Adviser to gauge needs of each family
- Bespoke workshops designed around individual family needs
- Feedback on progress and next steps
- 4-8 families attend 1.5hr long sessions every week for 6 weeks or one off drop in sessions
- Whole family to attend including siblings across the school
- Thrive assessments and action plans if desired
- Opportunity for SENCo/PSA to join in with sessions to support CPD
- All equipment provided, although I would need to use school tables and chairs





A typical session looks like:

- 15 minutes with parents to chat, get to know each other and seek advice over a cup of coffee
- 1 hour of activities with parents and children- active, creative and play based. There will be lots of fun and laughing to be seen!
- 15 minutes with parents after the children return to class. We debrief the session and look for positive strategies to take away and use at home
- Ideally workshops to be held in an area such as the school hall. Access to an outdoor area would be a great addition.
