Personal, social and emotional development PSED	We will look at the children's friendship in the story. At first it is two children then a new child appears. We will talk about how one of the children might feel left out now there are three. The qualities of friendship will be explored and we will talk about how we can be good friends to one another.	
Communication & Language C&L Literacy L	The text for this week is, 'On Sudden Hill' this book is about two children who go to a place called Sudden Hill with boxes. The children use their imagination to turn their box into different things and have lots of great adventures. The children in Longleat Class will think of an adventure they might have with their box. We will make a class book about all the different things the boxes might become. The children will write a diary entry about their adventure with their box.	
Mathematics M	In Maths, we will continue to consolidate the children's knowledge of number. We will be looking at sequencing five random numbers from smallest to largest or largest to smallest. The children will continue to work with tens frames to say what number they see and how they see it. We will also begin to look at 3D shapes. We will identify the names of these and discuss the properties of the shapes.	
Understanding the world UW	We will create a map of the imaginary journey we take in our 'boxes'. If you have any pictures from the half term please can you upload them to Tapestry so your child can share what they did?	
Physical development PD	This week we are fortunate to have two sessions of PE and also a session of Outdoor Learning with Mrs Matthews. Going forward PE will move to Wednesday alongside outside learning. Children should wear a T-Shirt with a long sleeve top over it and a pair of trousers. Ideally these would be clothes that you don't mind getting a bit dirty as the children will be outside all afternoon.	
Creative development CD	The children will decorate and transform a box and then tell a story about an adventure that they have in their 'box'. We will also be learning some friendship songs.
