

	<p align="center">Activities in Longleat Class WB: 12.07.2021</p> 	<p align="center">Farmyard Hullabaloo</p> 
Personal, social and emotional development PSED	This week in our Jigsaw sessions, the children will be celebrating how they have changed during their time in Reception.	
Communication & Language C&L Literacy L	This week we will continue to look at the features of non-fiction texts as we find out more information about the animals we saw at the farm. We will look at the features of a recount. The children will write their own recount of their visit to the farm. The children will look at photos from the farm and share their favourite memories. I'll endeavour to get them uploaded as soon as possible to Tapestry. Again, we will be reading a range of fiction texts linked to farms such as Farmyard Hullabaloo.	
Mathematics M	In Maths, we will be playing race to 30 with the children. The children will add counters to their tens frames according to their dice throw and the first child to 30 will be the winner. We will be using a range of number cards and the children will order them from smallest to largest and largest to smallest. Year 1 – Children will be finding out about the different UK coins and the values attached to them.	
Understanding the world UW	This week the children will be comparing two different animals and say what is similar or different. The children will continue making a farm on Simple City.	
Physical development PD	We will be going out in the garden with Ms Matthews. In PE the children will be continuing to work on their team sports skills.
