Phonics: Mrs Johnson led visiting teachers and teaching assistants from another local school to look at the high standard of teaching in phonics.

Reading: Miss Smith and Mr Williams monitored reading across Key Stage 2.

Playtimes: Mrs Johnson and Mr Williams looked at playtimes to ensure that children are safe and happy.

French: Mr Williams watched a lesson in Year 4 to assess the standards of teaching from our visiting French teacher from Wellington, Miss Eddy.

British Values: Individual Liberty

This week's British Value focus is on Individual Liberty. Jasmine and Suhana in Snowy Owls can explain it:

What is Individual Liberty?

Individual Liberty means that each and every one of us has the freedom to make their own appropriate choices. In addition, we know everyone has rights and responsibilities, therefore we know that we need to work within boundaries to keep safe.

Why is this British Value relevant in school?

In school, this means everyone has their own choices including joining extra-curricular clubs (e.g. dodgeball, Young Voices, art etc).
