#### **Parking Outside School**

This week there have been a number of incidents where parents have driven down the road towards the gates and then been unable to reverse. This is highly dangerous and I have spoken to 2 parents about reversing over the pavement whilst close to children.

## Parking or turning on pavements is illegal and highly dangerous.



#### **Home Reading**

Reading is one of the most important ways to support your child's learning in all subjects. Therefore regular home reading to an adult is essential. It helps develop learning in every subject! Even if your child is a fluent reader in Key Stage 2, home reading is still very important. The reading challenge has been a big success so far this term and most children have been reading between 3 and 5 times per week.

If for any reason, you are struggling to read at home with your child, for example due to working hours or deployment, please let us know as soon as possible. We can put additional reading in place for a period of time to support your child.

Please read with your child at least 3 times per week and let us know if you need additional support.

#### **Christmas Songs**

Next week we will be recording Christmas songs to share with parents. You will be sent a permission form via email. If you chose not to complete this, your child can still learn the song, but they won't be recorded in the final video.

#### **Guidance on Symptoms**

If your child develops any symptoms of Covid-19, he/she and any siblings must not come into school for 10 days from the first day of the symptoms.

Symptoms are:

High temperature; New/Continuous Cough; Loss of Smell or Taste

You must arrange for your child to be **tested** as soon as possible.

If your child receives a **negative test**, he/she and any siblings may return to school.

If your child receives a **positive test**, he/she and any siblings should remain off school for 14 days from **the date** of the positive test and <u>school must be notified</u>.

If it is known that your child has been in contact with someone who has tested positive for Covid-19, your child must isolate for 14 days, even if they have no symptoms.
