Uniform

A reminder that all children must be wearing smart school uniform each day. Trainers are not part of school uniform. Ties must be worn in Years 5 and 6.

Covid Update

Although cases in school are now much lower, please continue to follow the following rules:

- Children should not come to school if they are unwell, even if their illness seems mild.
- Children must self-isolate for at least 5 clear days when testing positive and only return after 2 negative tests (and no temperature).
- Children must take a PCR test if the have a continuous cough, high-temperature or loss of taste/smell.
- Children should do daily LFTs when other members of the household test positive.

Science at Zouch!

Next week at Zouch, the children will be lucky enough to engage in some exciting online workshops to explore the world of Science!

Children in Nursery, Reception and KS1 have a Terrific Towers challenge that will see them talk to real engineers and explore how columns are used to give us light and space in the buildings we use every day. They will also take part in 'Logo Lift Off!' which is a competition by the UK Space Agency to design a logo that could go on the first rockets ever to be launched from the UK!

Children in KS2 will have a fantastic workshop with TV's Marty Jopson that will explore forces and states of matter through exciting demonstrations, such as the pendulum of doom and the maths of a karate chop. They will also engage in a workshop called Wonderstuck Forces and Energy, looking at how we can transform one type of energy to another.

Please ask your children lots of questions about these brilliant events that have been made possible by Festival of Tomorrow and see the attached flyer for half term opportunities.
