Safeguarding - Cameras on Devices

These days most mobile devices, tablets, laptops and even some watches contain cameras. These are great for keeping in touch with people and many people made use of them during lockdown when we couldn't see family.

Last week there were reports in the news about how cameras can be used inappropriately with children. Unfortunately, a minority of people use chatrooms, games or social media to encourage children into video chat which can often be harmful. Serious incidents of harm against children using cameras rose dramatically during lockdown.

Please make sure you know which devices in your home have a camera and do not let children use these unsupervised, particularly in their bedrooms. It is essential that you know who your child is communicating with and how they are doing so.

- If a child has a positive COVID-19 test result they should stay at home and not attend school for 3 days after the test.

Children with mild symptoms such as a runny nose, sore throat, or mild cough, who are otherwise well, can continue to attend their education or childcare setting
