
Safeguarding Update

Online safety is one of the most important things you can do to keep your children safe. When playing computer games, you need to check the PEGI rating to ensure the game is appropriate: <u>https://pegi.info/</u> This is the official rating system and children are not safe if playing games above their age range.

Another useful website is Common Sense media: <u>https://www.commonsensemedia.org/game-reviews</u> This does not give official ratings, but allows parents to review the suitability of games for children.
