Dear Year 6,

Welcome back to school. I am very excited to be your new teacher and I am looking forwards to seeing you on Thursday (September 3rd). Here are a few reminders and some important information that you need to know for your return to school.

Safety rules: each class will be in a bubble and we won't be able to mix with other bubbles at playtime, lunchtime or around the school. There will be some extra rules in the classroom and around school that we will explain this week and it is very important that we all follow them at all times to make sure we are keeping everyone safe. Some adults will be wearing masks around the school, but not for teaching in the classroom.

Arrival on site: parents will have already received a letter outlining arrangements, but just as a reminder, you will need to come into school through the main gates on Avening Street. I will be on the playground to meet you at 8:30 when your parents should leave you in the line and exit the school via the park gate. All adults and children need to wear face masks on the playground before and after school.

What to bring: you will need a named water bottle, a named lunch box (easy to clean), a named coat and a named bag (e.g. a sandwich bag) for your face mask, which will be kept in your locker. You may also bring a healthy snack with you for playtime; there will not be a tuck shop.

PE kit: for the next two weeks, you will need to wear your PE kit to school on Monday and Wednesday. After that, it will only be needed on a Monday. You will need trainers, shorts or joggers and a white T-shirt and your school jumper.

Jars: as part of our learning over the next two weeks, we will be making mindfulness jars. Each child will need a small, clean (no label), transparent jar. Please bring in a jar for yourself and any extras you have at home to help. Please label the bottom of your jar with your name.

Leaving School: the day for Year 6 finishes at 3:15 pm. Your teacher will take you out to the playground at this time and you will wait with her until you are released to your parent. It is important that you and your parent leave the playground via the park gate as soon as school is finished.
