## <u>English</u>

For English this term, we are going to be using the text 'FArTHER' to base our skills writes around. We will be learning our final few skills in Year 5 and be brushing up on all skills in preparation for the transition to Year 6 in September.

#### **Religious Education**

In RE this term we are continuing to ask ourselves What does it mean to be a Muslim in Britain today and learning about Islam.

# <u>Art</u>

This term in art we are going to be developing our water colour skills. First, we will spend some time looking at complementary colours and cool and warm tones. We will then progress onto looking at some artwork of poppies and sketch some of our own ideas for a poppy inspired piece of artwork. The children will then finish the unit of art by creating a final watercolour piece of their poppy field.

### <u>Music</u>

Our music this term will be rehearing our clarinets and our singing in preparation for the Y4/5/6 Music Extravaganza and performing to all of our families and friends!

### <u>Maths</u>

This term in maths we will be finishing off our maths learning by looking at area, recognising and measuring angles, and finally finishing off with some statistics work.







#### Physical Development

This term, both Year 5 classes will be doing athletics in PE in preparation for sports week. We will also be continuing our trips to Nova for some extra PE also.

## <u>History</u>

History will be all about World War 1 this term. We will be learning about when this was, when it ended, how it started and which countries were involved. We will look at what life would have been like for soldiers in the trenches on the Western Front as well as what life was like for people back at home. To finish off, we will learn about Armistice and

Remembrance Day and why poppies are often used as a symbol for this.

## PSHE

This term in PSHE we will be covering SRE. We will be looking at the changes that girls and boys will go through when they reach puberty and how this will affect them.

#### Computing

Computing this term will be looking at coding. We will use two different programs (Scratch and Purple Mash) to have a go at using coding to create a game. We will evaluate our games and how effective they are and how we could improve them. The children will also compare the two programs and identify positives and negatives about both.

#### <u>Science</u>

For science this term we will be covering a variety of topics and touching on some previous learning throughout the year to further embed this. We will be conducting lots of investigations and experiments to develop of skills on conducting fair tests.
