

Welcome to Term 6, our final term together in Year 5!

Whilst COVID restrictions have now lifted in the UK, we are still asking you to be vigilant with testing if you can. Please inform the school and respective class teachers immediately if your child has a positive LFT or PCR result and currently we would still like your child to isolate for three days if they test positive. Children do not need a negative LFT result to return, only to feel better.

A reminder that doors will be open from 8.40am, with the register being taken at 8.50am sharp. We would like to stress again the importance of children's punctuality and attendance in Year 5, as this is really important for your child's learning. Pick up time is at 3.20pm and 1.30pm on Fridays.

For our final term together in Year 5, we have lots of lovely activities and learning planned to enjoy together e.g. The Y4/5/6 Music Extravaganza, Fun Week, Sports Week etc. For English, we will be using the text 'FARTHER' by Grahame Baker-Smith to inspire our writing. In maths, we will be finishing off the year looking at area, identifying and measuring angles, and some statistics work.

A polite reminder that children are expected to read every evening and this is to be recorded in their reading records. We would like to ask that all reading records are brought in daily to allow adults to write in children's reading records when they read with them. We will give pupils a new book to read once they have finished the one they are currently reading. They should also practise their spellings which the children should write down in their reading record on a Monday and practise their times tables daily (Times Tables Rock Stars is great for this). We will be sending home a homework web for the children to choose some homework activities linked to our topic to complete by the final week of term. We will also be continuing with the weekly maths homework this term in preparation for the move up to Year 6. This can be done in their homework books and either returned to school or photos of their work sent on Class Dojo when completed.

Children will continue getting changed for PE in school this term so children must have a PE kit in school at all times. PE may vary which day it is on this term and we may do more than one PE lesson a week, so please make sure your child has a PE kit in school at all times. A reminder that children should be wearing a PE kit in line with the school's PE uniform policy: white top, black shorts/leggings/joggers and a black jumper if needed. Earrings need to be removed or covered with tape on these days and long hair tied back.

Please make sure that your children come to school with a healthy snack and water bottle every day. It is advisable for children to wear a sunhat at play times whilst the weather is nice. Classroom windows will remain open at all times as much as possible still to keep the rooms ventilated, which should be less of an issue as the weather begins to improve. We are still encouraging children to wash their hands and use hand sanitiser as much as possible to try to keep everyone safe.

We are still happy for children to bring in their own pencil cases from home and their school bags to bring their things from home.
