Our weekly singing lessons with our singing teacher will continue to develop our singing voices and help us learn new songs We will listen to a variety of music and watch a string Music Roadshow.


Physical Development

Reception

Literacy

We will be starting this term by reading the story 'Aliens Love Underpants' by Claire Freedman. Following this, we will also read 'How to catch a star' 'Astro Girl' and 'Look Up'.

We will continue to develop our sentence writing skills, using our sound-letter knowledge from our Little Wandle daily phonic lessons. We will use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops and memorise our sentences before writing them. We will also re-read our sentences to make sure they make sense. We will be writing sentences based on the books we have read.

Personal Social and Emotional Development PSHE & Values

We will be following the Jigsaw scheme of work focusing on 'Relationships'. As we are a Values based school we will be exploring the value of Resilience and we will be testing our resilience and perseverance as we set a variety of challenges this term.

Mathematics Development

The children will explore estimation and use the sentence stems 'I estimate there are more/fewer than 5/10' We will be ordering numbers from smallest to biggest and biggest to smallest. We will continue to add and subtract numbers using a variety of resources. We will learn how to doubles and halve and make groups equal. We will continue to develop our reasoning skills by completing 'I know this because....'

Understanding the World

The children will continue to explore their immediate environment and learn any new vocabulary associated with it. They will also look at aerial photos of their immediate environment and make comments on what they see. We will also explore space and learn specific vocabulary to describe it. We will use images, video clips and a space dome to bring space into the classroom. We will continue to keep an eye on the frogspawn we found in the school pond at the end of the last term.
